

# THE 2006 SEASON

## Introduction

The 1<sup>st</sup> XI finished in a disappointing mid-table position in Division 2 and failed to confirm their potential at both individual and team level. The need for a strike bowler (or two) to support the ever-willing Adrian Carr (33 1<sup>st</sup> XI league wickets) was never more noticeable, and although Faisal Mir bowled with aggression to take 20 wickets, he was short on luck and consistency. The only really redeeming factor was Jamie Jouning's batting which has matured to an art form. As a 'home grown' player, his reliability was remarkable as he garnered 649 league runs at an average of 59. He was supported by the returning Perth batsman Brayden Sutton (518 runs) and Ben Hartman (368) who, although invariably entertaining as ever, has matured into a serious batsman.

Jamie Jouning was awarded the Hawker Trophy for his achievements, and a tribute to his batting which won the game at Wembley was summed up by skipper Alvin Durgacharan:

*"Believe me, it was one of the best innings I have ever seen. Jamie Jouning played a superb 112 not out to see us home. He had a bit of luck to get a hundred but his sheer determination and with everything else going against us on the day we fully deserved it. He hit 4,6,6, to finish the game off. In my opinion the innings was even more special as he had no partner come in and make a quick 20 nor was there any partnership over 40 meaning that J had to ensure he survived whilst keeping us up with the rate against the regular fall of wickets for the entire 50 overs. We finished 211-9 in 50 overs."*

The 2<sup>nd</sup> XI won the Second Division title and so commence 2007 in Division One. This was achieved largely through the formidable batting of Andy Hoskin (406 runs), and solid backup from Paddy Robinson (385) and David Woffinden (330), with consistent innings from Jeremy Sambrook. Middlesex County League titles are won more through taking valuable wickets than creaming runs on flat tracks, so Arshad Bhatti's 37 wickets at a parsimonious 14.37 were key to the side's success and deservedly earned him the League Bowling Award. Adam Vinson made a welcome return to the club as an effective and competitive all-rounder.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> XI ended five points from safety and suffered relegation to the Second Division for 2007. Richard Marshall scored the most runs (310) while five others exceeded 200. As is often the case, wickets were hard to come by though Fawad Mullahzada with 22 wickets (and on his day some tempestuous batting displays) and 'Bunny Singh' were the most successful bowlers.

In the Middlesex 1987 League, the 4<sup>th</sup> XI maintained a comfortable mid-table position in Division 2. The major contributors were, in batting, Ricky Gunn (291 runs), Mel Dowsett (236) and Akshay Jain (232). Mike Millar began to show his potential by exceeding 200 runs and averaging over 40. Only four bowlers took ten or more wickets, and of those, it was really only the senior partners Stuart Cradock and Len Stokes who were really capable of putting the brakes on the opposition batsmen.

The need for new effective playing membership has never been more critical if Southgate CC is to restore its reputation as a leading North London Club.
