THE 2008 SEASON

Ricky Gunn

What goes up must come down ...well, much of the time

The 2008 season began with high hopes, with all three of Southgate's Middlesex League XIs taking their places in the top divisions. By the end of the summer only the 2nd XI survived in that exalted status as the 1st and 3rd XIs suffered disappointing seasons to the extent that relegation was unavoidable. The perennial difficulty at the top level is to dismiss oppositions, and the quality of the 1st XI's opponents served to illustrate the inescapable void in ability between the premier and second divisions.

However, there were many bright moments and we enjoyed strong commitment from our former Australian Under-19 international from New South Wales, Adam Fleming, who scored 540 League runs (including a masterly 162 not out at Brondesbury) and took the most wickets (27, including a match-winning 7-43 against Stanmore) as an opening bowler. For these outstanding achievements on the field Adam was awarded the Hawker Trophy at the end of the season. Jamie Jouning and captain Alvin Durgacharan (with one century) both exceeded 400 League runs to underline their class at Middlesex premier division level, and although Faisal Mir took 23 wickets, the difference between the divisions was again emphasised by their cost at 33.47 as against 52 at 14.38 in the lower division last year.

The 2nd XI finished seventh for the second consecutive year in the 2nd XI top division and were always clear of relegation considerations.. Dave Woffinden 351 and Jamie Wilson 238 (including a 107 against Eastcote but a further 138 runs in the 1st XI) were the major run contributors while the bowling was dominated by Adrian Carr with 35 wickets at 15.60 and Rashid Mullahzada with 26 wickets at 17.88.

Last year's promotion to the top division was not sustained by the 3rd XI. New arrival Simon Hughes scored 290 runs at 32.25 and was supported by fellow newcomer Mo Khwaja, along with Richard Bishop-Laggett and Richard Marshall (who scored a fine 121 against Richmond) and who all well exceeded 200 league runs. However, the instability of the side was illustrated by the fact that no fewer than 53 players represented the 3rd XI, largely through indifferent availability higher up in the club. Only four bowlers took ten or more wickets, with Sam Faruqi leading with 16, although Sameer Faiz provided a memorable moment with a return of 7-24 against Hampstead.

The 4th XI maintained a safe seventh position in Division 2 of the 1987 League. Ricky Gunn and Doug Gordon each scored 279 runs but the geriatric demeanour of the side was enlivened by the emergence of 15 year-olds Dan Simms and Paul Lassman who each took their maiden

five-wicket league hauls. Skipper Len Stokes led the way with 38 League wickets (plus two more for the 3rd XI) while Dan Pyzer-Knapp showed considerable promise as a wicketkeeper-batsman.

In all games over the season, the top run-scorer was Simon Hughes with 932 runs, followed by Alvin Durgacharan (766) and Adam Fleming (729). 16 year-old Partha Dave scored five fifties in a successful first full season of adult cricket. The top wicket takers were Len Stokes with exactly 50, Adrian Carr (43) and Paul Lassman with a very creditable 41 with his leg-breaks.

The Club Dinner in March produced a disappointing turnout of only 49 and, coupled with the enormously increased hire charge for Bush Hill Park Golf Club, has probably tolled the final bell for a dinner of this nature. Nevertheless, those who attended had an enjoyable evening and were entertained by speeches from Alf Langley and Jeremy Dangerfield. Jeremy conducted a very successful Quiz Night in May although the end of season curry supper was attended by a mere 24, which only serves to endorse the sentiment that competitive cricket is the only real incentive to turn up at the club, even if there are awards to be handed out.

Career landmarks: Congratulations to Alan Jenner on passing 25,000 runs for Southgate, William Dean 13,000 and to Alvin Durgacharan 10,000. Adrian (Sage) Carr has now taken exactly 900 wickets. Career averages for all those for whom figures have so far been calculated begin on page 23.
