THE 2018 SEASON

Southgate Cricket Club

In common with these publications in recent years, the 2018 season edition of the Southgate CC Annual Review is largely statistical in nature. However, the carelessness of the scorebooks in so many cases – and especially any documentation relating to the Middlesex Development League (“Under 21”) matches – is immensely disappointing as far as recording the ball-by-ball history of the club is concerned. As in the last few years, even reference to opposition contacts has failed to elicit missing information so the club annual batting and bowling averages are deficient in a number of cases including a 1st XI cup match. The obvious knock-on effect is that individuals’ career aggregates and averages are also compromised.

Unfortunately, this criticism of a pervading attitude towards lack of commitment is worsened by the fact that 2018 was a singularly unfortunate year for the club on the field of play, a situation which is eminently reflected in the statistics that follow. The prime cause was that, for varying reasons, some ten players who had, at some time or another, represented the 1st XI in 2017 decided to move away from Southgate. At the same time several regulars from further down the teams chose to leave or stopped playing altogether. Coupled with that, early in the season it proved impossible to get youngsters to play while they prepared for exams. This is not the place for explanation or retribution but it left skipper Phil Dunnett with the mammoth task of rebuilding a side in which, to all intents and purposes, he was remarkably successful. The lack of players, however, meant that after the first five 4th XI league matches were conceded through being unable to field a side, the team was excluded from the competition. Only on three occasions were we able to field a “friendly” fourth eleven which meant that aspiring youngsters had little opportunity to play and progress their transition from 20-over evening colts cricket to the full afternoon game.

The 1st XI began the league campaign quite promisingly and were tantalisingly close to winning several early games, but eventually could not escape relegation to the 3rd division, a level heretofore never previously plumbed by the club. The highlight of the season was Tom Edrich’s innings of 100 not out of a total of 167 against Hornsey. Phil Dunnett had his best season with both bat (435 runs) and gloves (29 dismissals) and won the Player of the Year and Batting Trophies. Ravi Desai stepped up brilliantly to take 35 wickets while newcomer Daragh Edwards proved a very valuable addition to the team, enough to win him the Young Player of the Year Award. James Dangerfield took advantage of the absence of more experienced players to establish himself as a regular in the 1st XI and recorded his first five-wicket haul.

The 2nd XI were in the top division following promotion last year but with their better players being promoted to bolster the 1st XI they were outclassed most weeks. However, under the leadership of Jeremy Dangerfield they generally gave a good account of themselves and maintained a good spirit. However, relegation back to the second division proved an inevitability.

The 3rd XI contrived a satisfactory outcome in this difficult year. They frequently managed to score enough runs to give their strong bowling, led by Adrian Carr (a phenomenal 45 league

wickets in total), a chance of bowling the opposition out. Overall the 3rd XI won 7 out of 18 games. A particularly notable achievement was recovering from 50-7 against division leaders Brondesbury to reach a defendable 170 thanks to Rory Miscampbell's match-winning innings of 57. Rory was presented with the Dunkirk Award for this performance.

The club was pleased to welcome Steve Rowe as President in succession to Mike Smethers. Mike's contribution to the running of the club through a difficult period was extremely valuable and his enthusiasm and commitment were beyond reproach. Steve is already doing a fine job in maintaining contact with honorary members, including managing the annual summer lunch.

Congratulations and thanks again to Peter Jouning for maintaining the 200 Club which generates such regular and loyal support and which is so financially valuable to the club. In addition, Peter masterminded the annual December awards lunch, preceded by the Over 30s v Under 30s football match. As if this wasn't enough, Peter also found the time to compose a fascinating history of the club's historic cricketing benefactors, 'The Walkers of Southgate and Middlesex', to complement his previous book 'Southgate Cricket Club 150 Years' (2005). Again, very well done, Peter!

SCC Obituaries

Fred Ruoff died on 23 September aged 92. In professional life he was a stockbroker and economist, rising to a high position at the Stock Exchange. He became a Southgate playing member in 1954, being a very correct right-handed batsman and occasional leg-break bowler. His top score was 104 not out for the 1st XI against Wanstead in 1964. He stopped playing regularly in 1981 but turned out on rare occasions between 1997 and 2000 by which time he was 74. He also played regularly for the MCC, was a good hockey player, and a Christian gentleman in every sense.

Reg Ashby died aged 97 on 18th March. Reg and his wife Di were devoted supporters of the club during the heyday of the 1970s when their son Dick was a prominent 1st XI player.

Both members will be very much missed and the club sends its condolences to both families.

Southgate Colts 2018

There was a change in approach for the Colts in 2018. Ashraf Hosein was appointed head coach and he organised other professionals alongside the long term volunteers (Miles Stanton, Parinda Kularatne, Ricky Gunn and Doug Gordon) and some parents who helped with coaching on Monday evenings and games.

In a fantastic season the U15s were crowned Division Two Champions. This was achieved by having a magnificent team spirit and a squad of players who all contributed at some point throughout the season. The boys won six of their eight matches with two memorable wins over the mighty Winchmore Hill. There were some excellent batting displays by the top order batsman and in particular, William McLoughlin scored a fine 103 against Cockfosters, while captain Harry Showell scored three 50s and Jack Sclater scored two 50s. Three bowlers had three wicket hauls, George Hooper-Greenhill, Jack Brougham and William McLoughlin.

The highlight of the season was a decider match against Winchmore Hill to win the league. It was a home game on the main pitch. Winning the toss Southgate batted first and William McLoughlin and Callum Killeen went on to score a partnership of 80 in a creditable 131 from 20 overs. Winchmore Hill started well and looked set to win until Hari Popatia and Jack Eustance-Brougham bowled a fantastic spell of four overs for only ten runs allowing Southgate to successfully defend the total and to win.
