THE 2019 SEASON

Introduction

The best one can say about the 2019 season was that it was one of consolidation. Everyone was realistic enough to accept that the club was not going to quickly recover from the loss of key players eighteen months earlier and then having suffered relegation in 2018, conjure up an immediate resurrection in the league. The loss of those players has been aggravated by lower team players making themselves less available than in the past. The result has been an inability to field a 4th XI for the second consecutive year and at times the 3rd XI really struggled to get eleven men on the field.

In the event, the 1st XI finished fifth in the third division thanks to some excellent performances from the established players coupled with enthusiastic and improving support from the younger ones. The 2nd XI fared worst by getting relegated for the second successive year but they were the only real casualties as the 3rd XI managed to hold on at the end to preserve their 2nd division place.

Any optimism of the 1st XI staging an immediate return to the 2nd division was delivered a sharp blow early on with three successive defeats (albeit one by only 8 runs), but they then won six out of the next seven games and looked immensely like promotion candidates. However, the next win only came in the penultimate game of the campaign. Tom Edrich again scored the most league runs, with 491 at 37.77. Mike Stevens scored 468 runs at 36.00 and took 35 wickets at a miserly 14.11. Phil Dunnett took 20 catches and made 7 stumpings: his total of 27 dismissals was the best of any wicketkeeper in the entire league. New Zealander James Murray made an unbeaten 116 against Middlesex Tamils, scoring 231 runs overall at 46.20. Jamie Jouning soldiered indefatigably on with another 239 runs at 26.56 to extend his record Middlesex League aggregate (see page 10 for updated 1st XI league statistics). Matt Stratton made a welcome and valuable return with 223 runs (22.30). Daragh Edwards continued to build on his success of 2018 by taking 26 wickets (at 18.18) while Dave Woffinden took 24 wickets at 15.96.

Mike Stevens was awarded the Cyril Hawker Player of the Year trophy and Daragh Edwards deservedly retained the Young Player of the Year Award.

Finishing last in Division 2, the 2nd XI suffered a second difficult year. They maintained a positive spirit and beat the fifth side, Brondesbury twice, and have every reason to be optimistic in 2020. The batting looked remarkably solid. James Murray was the most successful batsman with 279 runs at an average of 55.80, while Adeel Saeed scored 230 at 46.00. They were supported by Max Joseph (261 at 26.10) Jeremy Dangerfield (232 at 21.09) and Declan O’Leary 221 (31.42). However, the bowling lacked edge and consistency. Of the 31 players who were called upon to bowl, seven took between 11 and 17 wickets but nobody took more than four wickets in an innings.

The 3rd XI under Dan Pyzer-Knapp endured a very difficult season through a desperate shortage of players. However, by hook or by crook they managed to stave off relegation so have another season in the 2nd division following a spirited win in the final match. DPK led by example and was the leading scorer (258 runs) with three fifties but lack of regular availability meant that no fewer than 52 people represented the XI throughout the season. On several occasions the side was augmented by some courageous but inexperienced colts for whom the leap into 3rd XI league cricket was a real baptism of fire. The three leading batsmen were only able to represent the side for a total of 12 matches between them, namely Rory Miscampbell (144 runs at 48.00), Kunaal Kankate (191 at 47.75) and Ali Lynch (140 at 46.66). Six bowlers took between 10 and 15 wickets but, again, 26 different bowlers turned their arm. The lack of a 4th XI during the last two seasons has meant not just a loss of transition from colts to adult cricket but also a loss of net match fee income of at least £3,000 for that period. This is without even considering more membership subs. People cannot be forced to play cricket but we need to recruit those who do with some urgency.

Hard times on the field were compensated by a hugely successful Reunion Match, the product of many months' planning by club president Steve Rowe. Former players from near and far (some more recognisable than others after the passage of time) congregated on Sunday 7th July. Peter Jouning's colourful report is reproduced later in this publication.

Steve has also turned his attention to fundraising. After many years of running the 200 Club single-handedly, Peter Jouning is looking to reduce his commitments to the club. Steve has taken it on himself to contact as many past, present (and hopefully future) participants in order to restore the membership to near maximum proportions. As Steve explains, the 200 Club is an important source of revenue at a time when some other income streams – for example Sunday cricket – are in decline. Coupled with the loss of 4th XI income, these are extremely valid points.

The Annual Review's content represents a statistical resumé of Southgate's 2019 season. To a substantial extent it has become a labour of love. Attempts to get previous editions readily accessible on the club website have fallen outside the compiler/editor's control. In addition, but even more irksome, is the diminishing information available in the scorebooks. Frustratingly, the Middlesex Development League matches were either only partially recorded or, in certain cases, no record was available at all, regardless of contacting oppositions during the winter to complete the data, although gratitude is expressed to those who were able to help. Catches are frequently not recorded and similarly falls of wickets, which of course makes the section on partnerships somewhat piecemeal. There is even a missing half of a 3rd XI league match which Finchley doubt they will be able to locate on our behalf. Additional figures can be added into the master records at any time should anything emerge at a later date. My only plea is that the scorebook is copied up after every game, if only from a photograph of the opposition's book. Otherwise, it renders Play-Cricket.com's self-vaunted club records meaningless and my own efforts equally pointless.

Updated career records of those for whom I have contrived time to research are available from page 21.

I hope this hasn't been too dispiriting an Introduction. My only hope is that Southgate Cricket Club can regain some former prestige by impressing on the field of play with skill and sportsmanship in 2020 along with some revitalised and some new players to lift all our spirits.
